BRIEF HISTORY

In 1977, Pakistan Railways Police was established following the merger of erstwhile Watch & Ward, and Government Railways Police (GRP).

Section 3 of Pakistan Railways Police act empowers Railways Police to;

- Prevent loss to Railways property;
- Keep a lookout for suspicious persons, smugglers, drug-peddlers and persons traveling with arms without a license;
- Render assistance to passengers & Railways servants;
- Protect travelers from injury to person or property;
- Take cognizance of offences committed in the vicinity of Railways;
- Search empty carriages for property left behind by passengers and to take possession of such property for due disposal under the law, and;
- Ensure proper conduct of persons on the Railways.

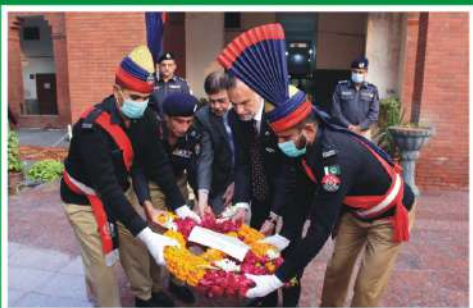

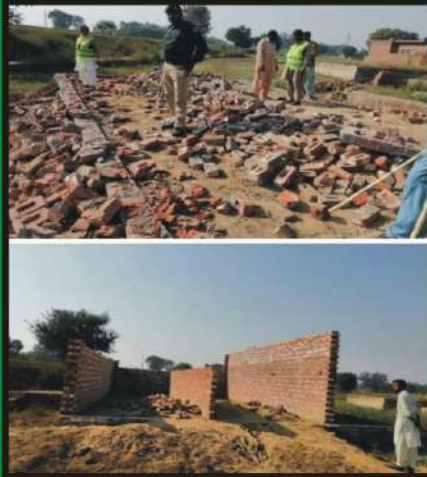
