**STANDING ORDER NO.42**

**SUB: RE-ORGANIZATION OF PAKISTAN RAILWAY POLICE ON  
PROVINCIAL POLICE PATTERN.**

In the backdrop of over-growing multifarious/multi-dimensional duties like the huge challenge of terrorism/sabotage in which the Railways department has been the main target in the past, excessive anti-encroachment duties, frequenting of foreign delegations/Chinese engineers for revival of the Railways network, influx of Sikh/ Hindu Yatrees by rail, the responsibilities of Pakistan Railways Police to provide security umbrella have tremendously increased manifolds. Due to factors mentioned above, it has become imperative to utilize both the posts of DIG/Headquarters and DIG/Operations equally with regard to discharge of duties and run the administration smoothly.

2. In view of the above narrated circumstances, there is need of the hour to re-organize the Pakistan Railways Police as elaborated in the succeeding paras in the interest of smooth and efficient functioning of Pakistan Railways Police:

I. At present there are eight Railways Divisions in Pakistan Railways Police all over Pakistan. Each Railway Division is headed by a Superintendent of Police, Railways. All the superintendents, Pakistan Railways Police are presently working directly under the command of IG/PRP unlike the provincial Police where District S.P functions under the supervisory charge of the Range DIsG, CCPO or RPOs. In order to streamline the system and make the working of Pakistan Railways Police more effective and administratively logical, henceforth, the Pakistan Railways Police will consist of two Zones constituted as below:



**i) Northern Zone consisting of the following Divisions:**

- a. Lahore
- b. Workshops Mughalpura (including RPTS/Walton)
- c. Rawalpindi
- d. Peshawar

**ii) Southern Zone consisting of the following Divisions:**

- a. Multan
- b. Sukkur
- c. Karachi
- d. Quetta

II) Both the Zones shall be headed by DIsG i.e., DIG/Headquarters (now DIG/North) with his HQs at Lahore and DIG/Operations (now DIG/South) with his HQs at Karachi. However, the salary & other utility bills/fuel etc of DIG/South will be charged at CPO, PRP, Lahore till transfer of his post to Karachi by the MOR, Islamabad for which a separate reference is being submitted.

III) **Duty list of DIG/North: (He will work as Principal Staff Officer to the IG, PRP)**

- i. Operational Command of SsRP of four Divisions & Principal RPTS/Walton regarding disciplinary matters, transfer/posting & inter-divisional transfer (within North Zone, however, inter-zonal transfer matters from North Zone to South Zone will be carried out with the consultation of both DIsG).
- ii. Promotional matters (as member & approving authority).
- iii. Monitoring the general crime situation in North Zone.
- iv. Supervision of anti-encroachment operation of Railway lands in North Zone.
- v. Procurement of all kinds of logistics and equipments.
- vi. Supervision of PSDP, CPEC & INL projects.
- vii. Supervision of PRP Special & Crime Branches.



- viii. Initiation of ACRs of AIG/Admn, DSRP/S.B & DSRP/Legal.
- ix. Countersign the ACR of SRP, staff of Admn. Branch, Special Branch, Crime Branch, Secret Branch, Misc Branch & PRP Foundation Branch.
- x. Supervising the security of key points & look after the security related to all CPEC related projects.
- xi. Deal with the religious & sectarian affairs & special trains.
- xii. Security of VVIPs/VIPs in railway premises.
- xiii. Security of foreigners & foreign delegations.
- xiv. Monitoring Railway labour union activities, maintenance of dossiers of labour leaders and updating their history sheets.
- xv. Court cases & audit paras reports.
- xvi. Matters related to PRP Welfare Foundation.
- xvii. Seniority, recruitment, training, budget & finance, transportation, oversee the matters of CPO, PRP, Lahore.
- xviii. Maintenance/constructions & refurbishment of all PRP buildings.
- xix. Ex. Pakistan Leave (up to the rank of SI in North Zone and for ministerial staff up to the rank of UDC)
- xx. Supervision of Stores, Clothing, Arms & Ammunition.
- xxi. References from Wafaqi Mohtasib, National Assembly & Senate concerned with CPO matters.
- xxii. Matters related to National Police Bureau, National Police Foundation & National Police Academy.
- xxiii. Monitor the monthly departmental punishments & disciplinary proceedings as per punishment matrix awarded to PRP staff.
- xxiv. Issuance of NOC to PRP employees for their appointment in other departments pertaining to North Zone.
- xxv. Allotment of official residences in the light of SOP issued by CPO.
- xxvi. Any other duty or function assigned by the IG, PRP.



IV) **Duty list of DIG/South: (He will work as Principal Staff Officer to the IG, PRP)**

- i. Operational command of SsRP of four Divisions i.e. Multan, Sukkur, Karachi & Quetta Divisions.
- ii. Disciplinary matters, transfer/posting & inter-divisional transfer (within South Zone, however, inter-zonal transfer matters from South Zone to North Zone will be carried out with the consultation of both DIsG).
- iii. Promotional matters (as member & approving authority).
- iv. Monitoring the general crime situation.
- v. Supervision of anti-encroachment operation of Railway lands in South Zone.
- vi. Supervising security of key points.
- vii. Deal with the religious & sectarian affairs.
- viii. Security of VVIPs/VIPs in railway premises.
- ix. Security of foreigners & foreign delegations.
- x. Monitoring Railway labour union activities & court cases.
- xi. Seniority, recruitment, training, Ex. Pakistan Leave (up to the rank of SI and for ministerial staff up to the rank of UDC).
- xii. Countersigning the ACRs of SsRP & ministerial staff of his Zone.
- xiii. Monitor the monthly departmental punishments & disciplinary proceedings as per punishment matrix awarded to PRP staff of his Zone.
- xiv. Issuance of NOC to PRP employees for their appointment in other departments pertaining to South Zone.
- xv. Allotment of official residences in the light of SOP issued by CPO.
- xvi. Any other duty or function assigned by the IG, PRP.

V) Both the DIsG Incharge of their Zones will exercise the powers and authority as per their duty supra, which DIG of a Range in the Province exercises and will



administer for forces in accordance with the provisions of Pakistan Railways Police Act and Rules made there under.

3. The DIsG being Incharge of the Zones will be answerable to IG/PRP. In the exercise of this responsibility, a DIG will interfere as little as possible with the executive authority of the SsRP under him and will permit such modifications of the practice and organization to suit local conditions as he may consider feasible as the laws and rules allow. He will use his power to control and to secure uniformed standard of efficiency and the fullest cooperation between Divisions and Branches of the force in the circulation of information and in action against criminals.

4. Compliance of above Standing Order will be made forthwith.
